

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

B.S. in Management and Public Policy Programme

Indian Institute of Management Sambalpur

1. What is the eligibility criteria for the B.S. in Management and Public Policy programme?

To be eligible, applicants must:

- Must have either passed their Standard XII/HSC or equivalent examination or be currently appearing for Standard XII/HSC or equivalent examination, with results expected by June 2026.
- Have a Min. 60% aggregate in all subjects in Standard X/SSC and Standard XII/HSC or equivalent examinations (General Category); 55% aggregate in all for SC/ST/OBC-NCL/ PwD and EWS Categories.
- Must have passed English language examination in Standard X/SSC and Standard XII/HSC or equivalent examinations
- Must have a valid **Integrated Program in Management Aptitude Test (IPMAT) examination 2026** conducted by IIM Indore.(mandatory for all applicants).

2. I missed applying for IPMAT 2026. Is there any alternate mode of admission?

At present, **IPMAT 2026 is the sole mode of admission**. Unfortunately, alternative scores like CUET, SAT, JEE cannot be accepted.

3. What if my Standard X and/or Standard XII or equivalent examination marks are below the prescribed percentage?

Candidates not meeting the minimum qualifying marks of 60% (or 55% for reserved categories) in either Standard X and Standard XII are ineligible to apply.

4. Is there any age limit to apply?

The maximum age for admission is 20 years as on July 31, 2026. However, relaxation in age will be provided as per Govt of India norms for the reserved candidates.

5. Will there be an interview or any other selection step beyond IPMAT?

Currently, admission will be based on the IPMAT 2026 scores and Online Personal interview for this cycle.

6. How many seats are available in the programme?

The maximum intake including the reserved categories for the programme is 90 seats.

7. Is there any reservation or preference policy?

Yes. Reservation of seats shall be applicable as per prevailing Government of India regulations.

8. What if two candidates have the same score?

In the event of a tie, preference will be given based on:

1. Higher Score/marks in IPMAT 2026
2. Higher aggregate marks in Class 12
3. Higher aggregate marks in Class 10
4. Younger candidate (based on date of birth)

9. What is the total programme fee? Is there an installment facility?

Detailed fee structure is available on our website. However, Fee payment has to be made semester-wise.

10. Are scholarships or financial assistance available?

Eligible students are encouraged to apply for govt sponsored scholarship schemes.

11. Are students from ICSE and ISC boards eligible?

Yes, all recognised boards including ICSE, ISC, CBSE, State Boards, and international boards are accepted.

12. Can international students apply?

Yes, International students and NRIs possessing the requisite qualifications including valid IPMAT 2026 score are encouraged to apply.

13. What are the NEP 2020 compliant exit options in the programme?

In line with NEP 2020, the programme offers:

- **Certificate** after 1 year
- **Diploma** after 2 years
- **Bachelor's Degree** after 3 years
- **Honours / Honours with Research** after 4 years

14. Can I get assistance on education loans?

IIM Sambalpur is an internationally reputed academic institution set up by the Government of India and you are unlikely to face any difficulty in obtaining an educational loan. However, the specific process and documentation requirements depends on the bank. The institute will support you to make available the necessary documents.

15. Where will the classes be held? Main campus or temporary?

Classes for the batch will be conducted at the **main campus in Sambalpur**, which is now functional with modern infrastructure. Hostel facilities are available within the campus.

16. Do I need to submit an official mark list, transcripts and certificates when I apply?

You will have to attach scanned copies of all your mark list/ transcripts and certificates in your online Application Form. It is mandatory to attach your grade X or equivalent qualification transcript. If you have received your grade for XII final or equivalent examination results, it is mandatory to attach the transcript.

17. Is it possible to apply before obtaining the grade XII final /board exam scores?

No. Students can not apply without obtaining their grade XII final/ board exam or equivalent examination results.

18. How do I compute the percentage of marks for application?

The percentage of marks obtained in Classes X & XII would be calculated based on the aggregate marks of all subjects that appear in the marks sheet or grade sheet, irrespective of whether the respective board considers them for the percentage calculation.

19. I have changed my name, according to due procedure, after completing my 12th/Diploma. Should I enter my name as per the 12th/Diploma certificate or the changed name?

You must enter your changed name and provide the supporting documents for the change of name at the time of examination, interview, and admission.

20. Which documents must I submit if I belong to the SC/ST category?

If you belong to the SC or ST category, your caste/tribe must be listed in the Government of India schedule. The caste certificate you upload in the Application Form should be in the government approved format.

21. What are the hostel arrangements and annual charges?

This is a fully residential programme. On-campus, air-conditioned, double-occupancy shared hostel facilities will be provided within the campus, and students are required to stay only in the allotted hostel. No student of this programme will be permitted to stay outside the institute without approval. The semester-wise hostel and mess fees are provided in the programme fee structure and are payable on a semester basis.

22. Will there be placement support for this programme?

Yes. IIM Sambalpur will offer **placement assistance** through its Career Development Cell, and engage with industry, government, and public policy think tanks to support internships and job placements. Under this programme several programs would be initiated through the placement cell to make the students ready and thoroughly prepared to take up challenging roles in the industry. Students are likely to get multiple opportunities to participate in the corporate recruitment process. However, the conversion cannot be guaranteed by the institution and the outcomes are dependent on the student's efforts and performance.
